Wednesday, March 13: Join us to make Lucky Charms marshmallow treats after lunch at Hope House.

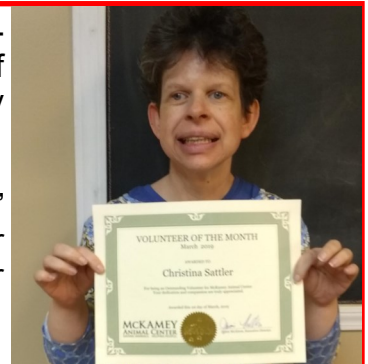
