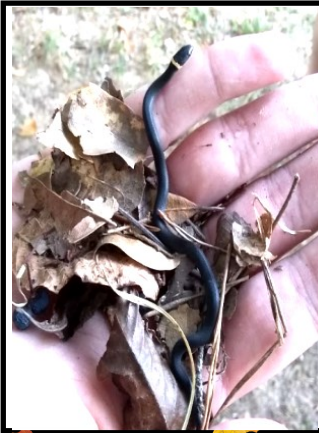




Susan, Sherolyn and Orlando at Fairview United Methodist Church. They sang a solo for the congregation & Susan read from her Braille Bible.
