Tuesday, Jan 28: Stuart Heights visits Faith House for dinner!

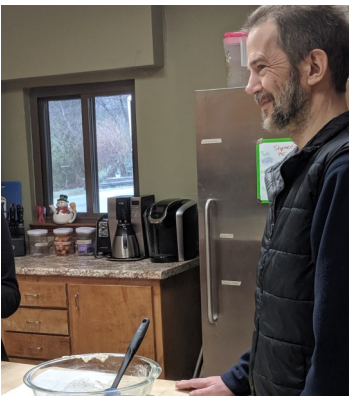
Tuesday, Jan 28: House meeting at Hope House - after dinner. **Very important!** Learn how to operate the new HVAC systems in your rooms.
