Sunday, Sept. 15: WalMart visit after lunch.



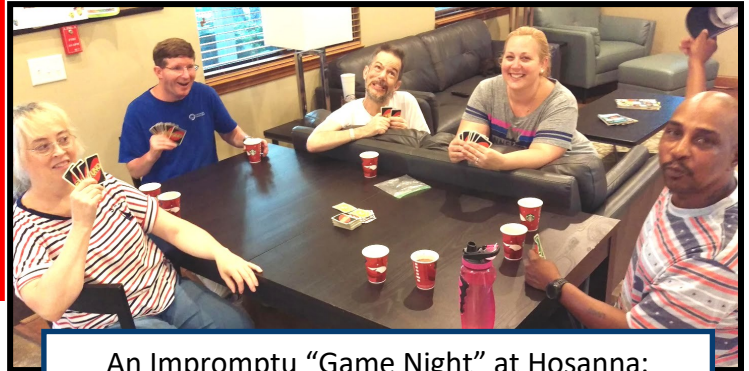
Monday., Sept. 9 is the most common American birthday. September has a higher birth rate births than any other month.
