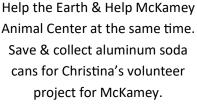

Today, I am going to reiterate a message from an Interim Rector of

St. Peter's Episcopal Church, who is a friend of mine, the Rev. Rob Nichols. His two years' service was responsibly spent explaining how we

all need to HONOR and SUPPORT our appointed bishop, his staff, our vestry, members and elected leaders, also including care for each other. He was adamant in expressing his goal of helping us feel the need to HONOR and SUPPORT their work. Admittedly, some of their tasks must be done confidentially and that requires trust. Interestingly, Rob wasn't discouraged to define his message. HONOR means to "respect changes given to Vestry members ... trust the system even when it's hard to do," and HONOR means to "give continued hope" through the power of prayer. SUPPORT, he noted, by asking: "where true help is needed," and continue "praying daily," to realize the benefits of being close to one another, professionally and spiritually.

Rob explained that to be successful in copying Julian of Norwich, known for saying: "all manners of things shall be well," one needs to trust in the Lord. HONOR God and seek SUPPORT from the Holy.
