Something has transpired over the last few months that has really encouraged and touched my heart.

Part of Hosanna's mission, as stated in our mission statement, is to encourage residents spiritually. Our residents are from numerous faiths, but we have always encouraged them to attend church on Sunday if they desire. However, we

have made it a point to let them decide how they choose to worship and do whatever we can to facilitate that without interfering.

A couple of weeks ago, I was in the kitchen and noticed two of our residents in the living room praying together. I knew one of them had had a very difficult day, and he approached another resident to pray with him. I have always known that on occasion residents had gotten together privately to pray. There was something so special watching from afar and seeing the "family" bond they were sharing.

Then something really amazing happened!

I recently stayed the night to help with dinner and eat with the residents. As always before we eat, we pray. I usually ask someone to pray so that everyone can have a chance. So...that is what I did. Then something magical and very unexpected happened.

Before praying, he asked for prayer requests and they went around the room asking for prayers. In my 13 years here, I have never witnessed this practice (or any other group prayer) initiated by residents. I was stunned. It was truly beautiful.

At dinner I asked when did this practice start? I was told they had been praying together for about the last two weeks. I told them I thought it was a wonderful practice and that I thought it set a positive tone for dinner conversation. It is nice to know that even after 13 years, I can be surprised by their depth of spirit and how much compassion our residents have!


